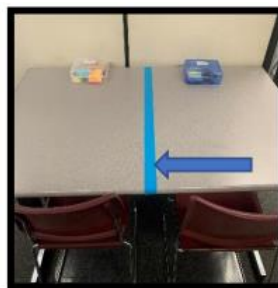
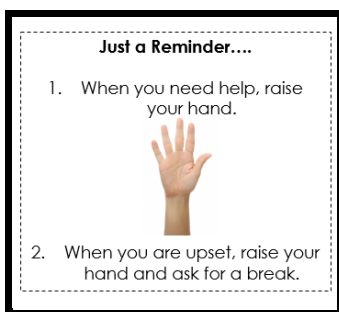
Evidence-Based Practice of the Month:

## Visual Supports (VS)

A visual display that supports the learner to engage in a desired behavior or skill, independent of additional prompts. (National Clearinghouse on Autism Evidence and Practice Review Team, 2020)
