DISCUSSION ITEMS

- 2. Updates from Community Advisory Committee Phil Stein, CAC President
 - a. Membership Roster and Recruitment (Attachment 2a) Still seeking active membership and recruitment. Phil Stein will not continue next year as Past President. CAC will continue with Marie Smith as Past President. Phil is going to focus on Disability Sports for his adult son.
 - b. Business Meeting Updates

Business meeting was held on Wednesday of this week. The previous CAC minutes were not approved, in the spirit of saving time the minutes were tabled. Christina Barrett, Program Specialist from Hemet Unified presented. She explained the difference of a Certificate versus Diploma Bound. Parents at times don't understand what it means for the future of their child. Talk with your Leadership team regarding when that discussion should start. As soon as conversation starts within the IEP team, discussion should begin with parents. So by the time the student gets to High School the parent understands. A parent advocate in the CAC meeting verified the fact that parents don't understand the difference of the two.

Parent advocate Alfredo Agurego from Inland Congressional United for Change, invited parents to a Riverside Unified by Disability Rights presentation next week. Leah clarified transparency with parents to advocate. He has met with Val Verde's Superintendent.

c. Upcoming Events

Currently, there is no location for the CAC Spring workshop. Awaiting CAC to find a location. Received criticism from the last workshop that it was held on a weekday.

Jess spoke at the last CAC Business meeting regarding Legislative Action Day. She also praised Alvord for handling her son very well on one of his bad days. Jess has already scheduled 4 appointments for our SELPA on Legislative Action Day. Appointments with Senator Stone, Senator Morrow, Assemblymember Medina and Senator Melendez. We have a slot for one more meeting. Kristin and her son along with Jess and her son are scheduled to attend. We have a new CAC representative; Member at Large, Shellie Milne. She was a former council member. She spoke very highly of Senator Stone.

3. Nonpublic School Updates - Leah Davis

a. NPS Review Update

Leah and Christa spent most of yesterday at Childhelp's CDE review. They were found out of compliance on a couple of items.

- Harmful effects for placed in NPS.
- Services didn't make sense. One file was reviewed from within our SELPA that
 has an overdue IEP. The annual was not held on time, and the LEA kept holding
 amendments. All dates of services were off. Some services had new dates, but
 the IEP was expired. All goals and objectives had expired.
- Insutructional minutes should be 360 minutes. Childhelp has changed their bell schedule to be in compliance. SELPA has changed our master contract to read 360 minutes as well.
- A general ed teacher is required to participate in each IEP. Need a Gen Ed teacher to call in, or utilize an excusal form. But don't make the use of the excusal form a pattern. There are ways we can work through it. CDE is taking it very serious.
- Transition box needs to be filled in. Any transition to or between programs. Leah will send out verbage. The team will be monitoring this.
- Other big area out of compliance is ISAs. SELPA is developing the ISAs. There
 is no back log at the SELPA level. The LEAs are holding up the process by not
 supplying proper documentation. Whoever is responsible for NPS' at your office,
 please talk to them. This is a funding and CDE issue.

No mention on compensatory issues. From here forward Childhelp's SAI is 360 minutes. 3 teachers hired on to meet compliance were brought out of retirement. They are now taking new students.

4. DRDP Update – Jeanne Bargman

Last Friday was the deadline to get DRDP certification reports in. Still have 6 districts with outstanding reports.

Preschool Consortium was standing room only. We had a Learning Genie demonstration from a San Jacinto teacher, Madeline. Jeanne gets reports on who is using the application. San Jacinto is using it consistently. Participants left excited on what the application can do. Jan Powell did a demonstration on DRDP reports.

5. Accountability Data and Activities – Leah Davis

a. Disproportionality Review

We learned this week that CDE has officially reorganized. FMTA's are now going to be assigned by speciality. Now we have 5 FMTAs. Leah reached out to Heidi Brahm and was told that they have had in new system in place since January. Leah will send out table with new FMTA assignments. We received no feedback regarding Disproportionality.

8. Riverside County SELPA Personnel Updates – Leah Davis

We interviewed for PD coordinator, but didn't select anyone. Position has been reflown. We now have 5 candidates, interviews should be moving quickly. The Monday after the position closed Leah was notified of the applicants. SELPA recommended to HR that we would like a clerk typist to replace Roxana's Bilingual Clerk position.
