## 5. Updates from Community Advisory Committee – Phil Stein, CAC President

#### a. Membership Roster and Recruitment (Attachment 5a)

This is the last Coordinating Council meeting with Phil as CAC President. Directors were encouraged to look at your membership roster and ensure that your district has appropriate CAC representation. Jennafer is the new CAC President; she is very assertive regarding recruitment and is willing to help in any way.

## b. CAC Workshop

Yesterday we had the opportunity to host the CAC Spring workshop, "Successful Development and Maintenance of IEPs". The day started with an Executive Board member sharing real life experiences. She walked the participants through how to put together an IEP notebook, and talked about having an organizational system. Christa followed up with "How to Effectively Participate in an IEP meeting". We had several presenters including, The Department of Rehabilitation, IRC and IEHP. We found out a lot that IEHP has to offer. They are willing to come out and present to your team, including parent groups. Jennafer has scheduled IRC presenter to present at first CAC meeting of 2018-19 school year.

An advocate attendee was present. SELPA is taking a very firm approach with him. Parents have come forward that they have concerns about him. He is making his way out to the Desert.

# 6. Nonpublic School Updates – Leah Davis

# a. NPS Review Update-

We have not received much feedback with our frequent flyers. How many of you are sending out an APE teacher to Childhelp? They are not certified to teach APE. Childhelp said their LEAs are sending out their own APE teacher. CDE said Childhelp cannot use an instructional aide for an APE instructor. SELPA sent out a gun protocol reminder. There have been two incidences at Childhelp and protocol was not followed. Gun protocol went out to NPS countywide, asking them

to follow the same process as an LEA.

SELPAs current balance is \$654,000. Part of the clerical salary is paid from Medi-Cal dollars; \$26,000 annually. SELPA is still using Paradigm as our billing agency, they receive 12% for their fees. The next Medi-Cal meeting will be in October. Medi-Cal funds cannot be requested for things that you are required to do.

# 8. Accountability Data and Activities - Leah Davis

# a. Disproportionality and Significant Disproportionality

Yesterday was the deadline for all corrective actions. SELPA has not heard from Melody at CDE. There was some confusion during this process. She took our recommendations and closed the loop in regards to CDE contacts. If you have not submitted your disproportionality, you can submit it today. Lisa (Beaumont) submitted her dispro. and received a list of all new items that CDE wanted. As soon as we know about the review we will let our LEAs know. Most of our LEAs are found in disproportionality. One district continues to be in dispro.

Next year for PIR we are skipping a year to close the gap and going into 2017-18 data. Next school year we will be aligned. Some of our LEAs are receiving data as feedback and other LEAs are receiving just a letter. Leah will follow up on this. We are now functioning in 2017-18 year.

#### b. Performance Indicator Review (PIR)

Discussed PIR last month. The assurance form, which was signed and submitted to CDE, stated PIR plans would be implemented by June 30<sup>th</sup>. There is nothing more that needs to be submitted to Vince. All LEAs have submitted their plans. We will revisit this in the fall.
