DISCUSSION & INFORMATION
ITEMS

10. Governor's Budget – May Revise

Provided update from School Services of California regarding Governor's revised budget proposal. Highlights specific to SELPA and special education included a slight increase to COLA (2.71%) that will be applied to special education dollars, \$100 M in one-time funding for LEAs to recruit and retain special education teachers, and \$10 M committed to identifying lead SELPAs to support COEs in the Differentiated Assistance work. Additional language indicated a requirement for SELPAs to complete a local plan template that demonstrates how services and resources noted in the local plan align with member LEAs LCAP goals and priorities. Governor's revised budget did not include ongoing funding to increase or equalize AB 602 rates.

11. CASEMIS Update

a. CASEMIS to CALPADS

CASEMIS to CALPADs transition is moving forward. The next school year will be crucial in preparing for the transition. RC SELPA is identifying resources and opportunities to support LEAs in the transition. Conversation on this topic will continue through the 2018-19 school year.

b. April CASEMIS Submission

All LEAs identified as needing to submit April CASEMIS did so in a timely manner. RC SELPA has communicated with the SELPA Administrators Compliance Committee regarding concerns specific to how LEAs are identified as having data identified non-compliance (DINC), resulting in the need for April CASEMIS reporting.

c. June CASEMIS Submission

All LEAs are prepping for June CASEMIS. The goal is 100% compliance.

12. Compliance Monitoring Activities

CDE has notified SELPA that 2017-18 APR will be released aligned to the California Dashboard release. This will allow Special Education Compliance Monitoring Activities to be conducted utilizing current data, rather than data that is 2 years prior. LEAs will be notified of Disproportionality status in the coming weeks and Disproportionality Student Reviews and Policy/Procedure Reviews will begin in summer or fall. LEAs identified for Performance Indicator Review (PIR) will begin the process following the release of APR (SPPI Indicators).

13. 2018-19 Nonpublic School Master Contract Revisions and Oversight

Three NPS have undergone "unannounced site visits" by CDE. We are currently waiting on the investigation reports. NPS rate negotiations are in process. No major revisions to the master contract.

14. SELPA Staffing Update

Kellie Kaukani has joined RC SELPA as the Coordinator of Professional Learning and GC Minutes 5.18.18

Development. Kellie joins RC SELPA after having served Hemet Unified School District for 14 years as a teacher, academic coach, special education program specialist, and most recently a coordinator of special education.

15. Community Advisory Committee Updates

RC SELPA CAC recently elected a new CAC Chair for the 2018-19 school year. Jennafer LaPaglia-Griswold has taken on this leadership position and is committed to increasing community and family engagement within our county. Jennafer brings years of experience both as a parent and educator and her energy around involving families in their childrens' education is unprecedented.

16. Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education and State SELPA Highlights

a. Legislative Updates

Highlighted AB 3136 (O'Donnell) that calls for equalization of AB 602 funding across SELPAs, additional funds to support preschool programs, and funding for "high cost disabilities" which includes all disabilities except specific learning disability (SLD), speech language impairment (SLI) and other health impairment (OHI). The bill is currently in the suspense file however we will continue to watch its progress closely.

b. Fiscal Updates

c. Program Updates

Update to graduation rates, specific to DASS schools. Concerns amongst the special education community that students will be placed in DASS schools as a "fix" to graduation rate rather than because the placement is appropriate. CDE will be monitoring for this by looking at increased enrollment in DASS schools within LEAs.
