#### 4. Governor's January Budget (Attachment 4)

#### a. Special Education Funding

SELPA Finance report. Document Attachment 4a PowerPoint presentation on Finance includes detailed information.

#### b. SELPA's Role in Differentiated Assistance

Competitive grant for support for Differentiated Assistance. 6 SELPAs statewide will be able to receive the grants and partner with county offices for Differentiated Assistance. In process of identifying supports that SELPA alongside county office can provide to districts. Professional Development and Learning Coordinator position will be used to support these processes.

#### c. LCAP Priorities

Discussion on SELPA LCAP priorities being modified to align with District priorities. CASBO is not in support of this position. They believe that this would add an additional layer to an already complex process. Push for AB602 funding.

#### 5. Compliance Monitoring Activities

#### c. Compliance Review

CDE has increased Compliance Monitoring Activities. PIR plans have been submitted on time. One district has been identified for Comprehensive Review. RC SELPA has been selected to fill a vacant seat on the State compliance committee.

#### 6. Nonpublic School Oversight

#### a. Childhelp

CDE REVIEW was conducted.

#### b. Terri Inc.

Has increased their rate and is not willing to conform to RC SELPA Master Contract requirements. SELPA has been withholding payments. RC SELPA is working with districts to move RC SELPA students to a different NPS. Terri Inc. is requesting and additional increase in rates for next year aligning with typical San Diego rates. RC SELPA is not in agreement with the increase.

RC SELPA has made NPS oversight one of their priorities. Mental Health team has assisted in ramping up their presence at our NPS.

#### 7. Charter School MOUs and Obligations

Who is responsible for SpEd services when a charter is part of the district? Response is that the Charter School is responsible. Some districts have an MOU with Charters to provide SpEd services. RC SELPAs position is that the Charter is responsible for their own services. Include SpEd Directors in Charter petitions especially in regards to provision of SpEd Services. Currently have 2 Charter requests. Discussion will need to be had in regards to limit ration of Charter schools vs. Districts as members of RC SELPA.

#### 8. SELPA Staffing Update

Two vacancies. Bilingual Clerk title changed to Clerk Typist III. No change in salary. Will be interviewing on Monday. Coordinator of Professional Learning and Development. Have not identified a right fit for the position. Position has re-flown. Need someone with a strong SpEd background and instructional and coaching background.

#### 9. Coalition for Adequate Funding for Special Education and State SELPA Highlights

#### a. Fiscal Updates

AB602-work being done to increase and also equalize. Discussion on Bills to support Equalization of AB602 funding and impact of funding to RC SELPA. Should result in a significant increase to RC SELPA districts.

Discussion of increase of funding for Pre-K. Possible increase in revenue for students that are eligible under moderate to severe disabilities (all disabilities other than SLD, SLI and OHI).

#### b. Legislative Updates

Proposed Bill on Translation of IEP documents. 30 day turn-around time for school district for top languages in a district. Could have a significant impact on the district due to timeline.

#### c. CAFSE & SAC Priorities

Fiscal Priorities discussion is primarily around adequate funding of SpEd. SpEd finance haring will be taking place in Sacramento in the next week.

#### **10. Governance Chair Comments**

Question on if the rate of SpEd students coming in to the districts increase in RC SELPA? Response, it is not slowing down. Statewide trend is an increase in SpEd through the State. Question on Dyslexia protocol. Each district is currently working on protocol. 1 to 2 strong models have been identified in our County. SELPA will be sharing this information.
